

Tu • Oct 31

Depart Washington, D.C.: Depart from Dulles International Airport on your South African Airways overnight flight bound for Johannesburg.

We • Nov 1

Johannesburg, South Africa: Arrive at OR Tambo Airport in Johannesburg and receive assistance with customs and luggage before transferring to your hotel. After enjoying drinks and appetizers, explore Johannesburg, one of the world's most cosmopolitan cities, on your own.

Th • Nov 2

Kasane, Botswana/Linyanti Wildlife Reserve, Botswana: In the morning, transfer to the airport and fly to Kasane before boarding a shared tour flight to Linyanti Wildlife Reserve. Spend the next three nights at Kings Pool Camp, featuring well-appointed, luxury tents, large bedroom area, lounge and private plunge pool.

Fr & Sa • Nov 3-4

Linyanti Wildlife Reserve: Over the next two days, experience the awe and excitement of Africa as professional guides in all-wheel-drive safari vehicles help you explore this incredible reserve close up. While especially known for its large elephant population, the Linyanti Wildlife Reserve features a variety

of wildlife, including antelope, giraffe, lion, leopard, cheetah, hyena, jackal and the rarely-seen aardvark and aardwolf. Birding here is spectacular.

Su, Mo & Tu • Nov 5-7

Okavango Delta, Botswana: Board your circuit light aircraft and transfer to Chitabe Camp, located on a beautiful island in the Okavango Delta, where you'll spend the next three nights. Chitabe Camp's eight spacious Meru-style tents are built on elevated wooden decks and feature twin beds, en-suite facilities and indoor/outdoor showers. The thatched dining area, pub and lounge area offer superb views of the delta's floodplain. During your stay, fill your days and nights with game drives in open 4x4 vehicles and nature walks. Be on the lookout for elephant, buffalo, lion, leopard, cheetah, giraffe, zebra, tsessebe, impala, wild dogs, civets, servals and more.

We • Nov 8

Victoria Falls, Zimbabwe: Fly to Kasane Airport, then transfer by road to Victoria Falls. Check into Victoria Falls Safari Lodge, set on a plateau overlooking the Zambezi National Park. All rooms are ensuite and feature a private balcony with views of the African bushveld and a central waterhole. Later, travel to the Zambezi River above the Falls for a sunset dinner cruise.

Th • Nov 9

Victoria Falls: Tour the Zimbabwean side Victoria Falls, one of the seven Natural Wonders of the World. Watch in awe as millions of gallons of water surge over the falls into a series of narrow gorges below. Continue to a nearby community where you'll visit a homestead and interact with the local people. In the evening, embark on a unique cultural dining experience prepared in traditional Zimbabwe style, and for the daring, grilled Mopani worms. Shangaan and Ndebele dancers and singers, storytellers and even a witchdoctor entertain you.

Fr • Nov 10

Johannesburg: Take a short flight to OR Tambo Airport in Johannesburg and connect with your international flight home.

Sa • Nov 11

Arrive in Washington, D.C.: Arrive at Washington Dulles and connect to your return flight home with memories to last a lifetime.
